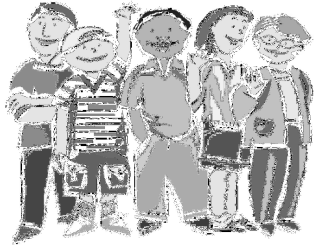


At First Evangelical Free church Awana is...



A program which centers around a weekly club meeting for boys and girls from pre-kindergarten age to sixth grade. Our club evening consists of three parts: Game Time with team competition; a session for Handbook achievements; and a Council Time where the Gospel is presented and young people are challenged to Christian lives and service. Our leaders are well qualified to guide our children and each is dedicated to Christian principles.

Awana Clubbers are eligible to wear an Awana uniform once they have passed their respective Entrance Test. After completing the Entrance Test your Clubber will be sent home with a handbook giving full details regarding Club uniforms and handbooks, and other club information.

Your child will benefit from Awana if you...

- ◆ Encourage your child's attendance at each club meeting and make sure they wear their uniforms and bring their Bibles.
- ◆ Take time to help encourage your child to learn his or her Bible verses and complete their activities.

- ◆ Meet our Club Directors and Leaders, know their phone numbers, and if necessary, inform them when your child has a special need.
- ◆ Attend the Sunday School of your choice. Attendance awards are handed out during the year.
- ◆ Have your child wear appropriate clothes for playing games. We recommend tennis shoes and long pants or walking length shorts to help lessen the chance of carpet burns or other injuries.
- ◆ Please bring your Clubber on time. Being on time helps the Club night start out on a positive note. Club starts at 6:25 p.m. Please try to arrive 5 minutes early.

Awards

Clubbers must attend the Awana meetings, as well as the Sunday School/church of their choice to earn both attendance awards.

Drill and Activity awards are earned with the completion of each section of the Clubbers Handbook for the younger clubbers.

T & T clubbers complete sections in their handbooks called Discoveries and Challenges.

Awana Store

Clubbers earn Awana Shares for passing sections in their Handbooks, for winning team competitions and for other accomplishments. Awana Shares can be spent in the store to purchase pencils, key rings, glitter batons, erasers, jump ropes, and many other small items.

Awana Shares can be saved up to purchase larger items such as Bible cases, kites, and videos.



Bible Quiz, Spark-a-Rama,

Awana Games and Grand Prix

Main events during the Awana year are the Bible Quiz, Spark-a-Rama, Awana Games, and the Grand Prix. Clubbers participating in the Bible Quiz are drilled on Bible verses and their general Bible knowledge. Medals and ribbons are earned for proficiency. A Spark-a-Rama is a team competition specifically for Sparks in which Clubbers compete in Awana games against other churches.

The Awana Games are for Clubbers in third through sixth grade and are held on the same day as the Spark-a-Rama. For the Grand Prix competition, Clubbers build their own pinewood derby cars from kits and compete against other clubbers. There is also an adult division for leaders and parents.

Used Uniforms

Used uniforms are occasionally available for half the cost of new ones. If your child is moving from one club to another, you can turn in your old uniform and get back half the cost of the old uniform. This will be applied to the cost of the new uniform. All used uniforms must be in good condition.

Dues

Dues may be paid in a couple of ways...

Nightly—\$.50
Yearly—\$15.00

Dues pay for Clubber's awards, game equipment, snacks, prizes and other items needed to ensure the continuance of our Awana Club.
